Chronological/ Sequence	To put events in order from earliest to most recent.
Compare	To look at similarities and differences.
Event	Something important that happens.
Artefacts	An object of historical interest.

Important People



- ❑ **Amy Johnson** – In 1930, Amy was the first woman to fly solo from London to Darwin (Australia). It took her 19 days.
- ❑ **The Titanic** – A ship used for sea travel where people were split according to their class.
- ❑ **The England Football team** won the world cup in 1966. It is the only time England have won it...yet! The final was at Wembley.
- ❑ **The Beatles** – A world famous pop group from Liverpool. Their music is still popular today.
- ❑ **World War I – 1914 – 1918.** Britain fought 'The Great War' against Germany.
- ❑ **World War II - 1939 – 1945.** Britain fought in a second war where children had to be evacuated to safety.
- ❑ **The Moon Landing** – In 1969 American astronaut, Neil Armstrong became the first man to walk on the moon.
- ❑ **The Coronation** – In 1953, Queen Elizabeth II was crowned as our queen.
- ❑ **The Suffragette Movement** – In the early 20th century, a group of women campaigned for the right to vote alongside men.
