







Year 1 Science: Seasonal Change Knowledge Mat

Autumn	The time of year between September and November. Many leaves fall off the trees.	   	<input type="checkbox"/> In the UK we have four seasons : spring, summer, autumn and winter.
Spring	The time of year between March and May. There is usually lots of signs of new growth in Spring.		<input type="checkbox"/> Spring starts when the day and night are the same length (usually 21 st March). Easter is a Christian festival in Spring.
Summer	The hottest season in the UK. It happens between June and August. The longest day is June 21 st .		<input type="checkbox"/> In Summer the longest day of the year is around June 21 st . We have the longest days (most daylight hours) in Summer.
Winter	The coldest season in the UK. We can have snow in this season. It occurs between December and February.		<input type="checkbox"/> In Winter , the shortest day of the year is around December 21 st . We have the shortest days (least daylight hours) in Winter.
season	A certain part of the year, marked by specific weather conditions.		<input type="checkbox"/> Autumn festivals include: Bonfire Night, Halloween. Christmas is a Winter festival celebrated by Christians.
weather	Weather is what the sky and the air outside are like (e.g. cold and cloudy).		<input type="checkbox"/> Some animals hibernate in Winter to conserve energy (e.g. bear, bat, tortoise).
temperature	It is measurement of hot or cold that can be measured using a thermometer.		<input type="checkbox"/> We can tell what season it is by thinking about the weather, the trees and plants, what animals are doing, and the clothing we choose to wear.
thermometer	This is the instrument that measures the temperature.		
weather symbol 	These are signs used to help us understand more about our daily weather.		
festival	a ceremony or celebration that repeats, often once a year, and involves special activities or amusements.		
hibernation	to sleep through the winter in a den or burrow to save energy
